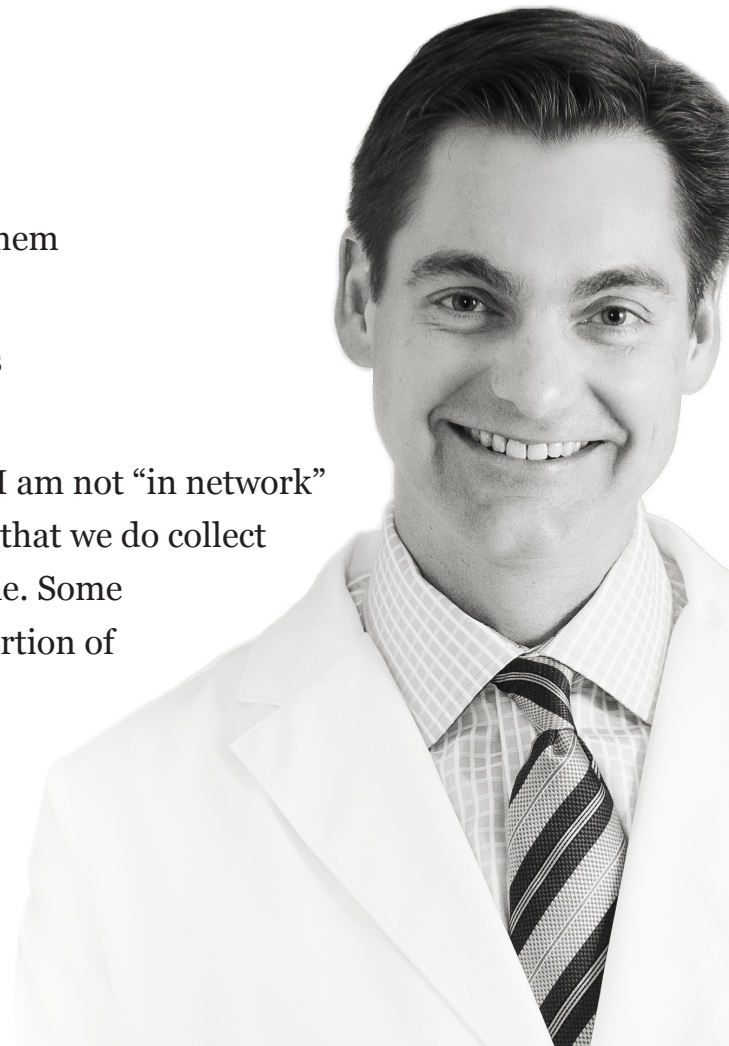
# Welcome

## WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

1. A valid photo ID
2. Glasses or contact lenses if you wear them
3. Eyedrops if you use them
4. A list of your prescription medications
5. The forms in this packet
6. Your insurance card. Please note that I am not “in network” for any insurance. What this means is that we do collect my fees at the end of your time with me. Some insurances will reimburse you for a portion of my fees after they have been paid.

In order to make your visit most productive, please complete the enclosed forms to the best of your ability before you arrive.



## ESTIMATED TIME OF YOUR VISIT

If this is your first time in my office, please allow up to two hours for your visit. I take pride in the thoroughness of my exams and will take the time to answer your questions. If you have another commitment scheduled on the same day as your visit with me, please leave sufficient time to safely get to your next scheduled activity. Also consider that dilation (which can last up to six hours) can impair your driving ability.

## PARKING

There is ample parking both on the street as well as behind the office. Please note that the rear entrance to the office is not handicapped accessible. Our neighbor, Cal Oaks Pharmacy welcomes you to enter through their accessible ramp and pass through the pharmacy on the way to my street front entrance. Alternatively, there is an accessible pathway to the east of the building.

If you are considering cataract surgery, this is an exciting time. Many patients undergoing cataract surgery are eligible to upgrade to advanced technology lens implants that focus their eyes for both far and near vision, allowing them to be glasses-free for most of their daily activities. Ask us about these exciting lens options.
