

## **Are You Taking Prostate Medication?**

The medication you take could impact your cataract surgery.

- Some medications used to treat the symptoms of an enlarged prostate such as Flomax, Hytrin, Cardura and Uroxatral - may create a risk of complications during cataract surgery.
- Even if it has been several years since you have taken one of these medications, called alpha-blockers, the risk of complications may still exist.

Tell your ophthalmologist if you are taking or have ever taken Flomax or another alphablocker. Your doctor can then use alternate methods to compensate for the effects of these medications.
